Brief Project Summary: This planning project will enable the Association to complete environmental review for the Effie Yeaw Nature Center's Master Plan and obtain approval of the Master Plan by Sacramento County. Additionally, engineering studies and designs will be completed for Phase 1 construction to bring this work to a shovel ready status. Phase I includes construction of a separate aviary adjacent to the Museum Building and replacement of the amphitheater with an improved and more useable outdoor education classroom. The new aviary will replace the outdated and substandard mews currently used to house live animals serving as ambassadors for the Nature Center. The existing mews will be converted into an improved animal care area.
