Boden Canyon Ranch – San Diego County

Boden Ranch is 160 acres of oak woodland and chaparral 6 mi north of Ramona in San Diego County. Cleveland National Forest and Boden Canyon Ecological Reserve can be accessed from the ranch.

Turkey hunts: (Each hunt consists of 2 days)

- Period 1: Nov 9-10 (application deadline is Oct 23)
- Period 2: Dec 7-8 (application deadline is Nov 20)
- Period 3: March 29-30 (application deadline is March 12)
- Period 4: April 5-6 (application deadline is March 19)

Dove hunts: (The hunt consists of 2 days)

• Period 1: September 1-2 (application deadline is Aug 15)

Quail hunts: (Each hunt consists of 2 days)

- Period 1: Oct 19-20 (application deadline is Oct 2)
- Period 2: Oct 26-27 (application deadline is Oct 9)

Property Rules:

- 1 permit will be drawn for each hunt period.
- Successful applicants can bring 1 hunting partner or 1 non-hunting partner.
- No camping, campfires or smoking allowed.
- This is a walk-in only hunt.
- You will need a USFS Adventure Pass to access Cleveland National Forest.
- Only NON-LEAD ammo must be used.
- Parking is available inside the gate with a 4x4 and a quarter of a mile outside of the gate for non 4x4 vehicles.
- Boden Canyon Ecological Reserve borders the property to the south of the property.
