General situation and animal information: Two older carcasses of calves were discovered on December 27 late in the day. Siskiyou County wildlife specialists investigated the carcasses the next day. The carcasses were estimated to be about 2 weeks old and largely consumed.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: There was no evidence of wolf predation

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: There was no evidence of wolf presence

Summary: The carcasses were too old and too consumed for a thorough investigation, therefore the cause of death is unknown
