

**Agreement with the Torch Trustee Council and California State Parks for the  
Information and Outreach Component of the Seabird  
Protection Network Phase VI  
4/10/2018**

The purpose of this document is to outline an agreement (Agreement) between the Torch Trustee Council (Trustee Council) and California Department of Parks and Recreation (State Parks) associated with the transfer of \$71,101 in funding from the Department of the Interior Natural Resource Damage Assessment fund to State Parks for implementation of restoration in accordance with the Torch/Platform Irene Oil Spill Final Restoration Plan and Environmental Assessment.

State Parks will work cooperatively with the Trustee Council relating to the Torch/Platform Irene, Seabird Protection Network- Environmental Information and Outreach Component, as described in the attached Scope of Work. State Parks staff and the Trustee Council will continue to work together on the development of outreach materials and the dissemination of those materials to reduce human disturbances to seabird colonies.

**Performance Period:**

The performance period of this award begins May 1, 2018 for an 18-month period. If necessary to optimize the allocation of these funds to the greatest benefit of seabird resources, the Trustee Council may alter or extend the period of performance upon request to the lead Trustee Council project officer for this project, Jennifer Gold (Jennifer.Gold@wildlife.ca.gov, 805-450-8695).

**Reporting Requirements:**

No later than 90 days after the expiration or termination of this Agreement, State Parks will submit to the Torch TC final financial and performance reports. State Parks is required to provide informal status updates (i.e., via phone or email) to the Trustee Council upon request. State Parks must notify the Trustee Council of any problems or delays that will impair the implementation of the project.


