General situation and animal information: On November 11, a cattle producer found a 100 lb. dead calf that had been killed by a predator. Siskiyou County personnel investigated the carcass that same day. The size and location of the bite marks were consistent with domestic dog.

Summary: Evidence indicated the calf was killed by domestic dog.
