Spill Response


- Mandates: Respond to spills of oil (petroleum and renewable) into marine and inland waters
- State Oil Spill Response Trust Fund
- Roles: Investigations, SOSC, EUL, SCAT, Wildlife Operations, JIC, LOFR, Volunteers, ART Specialist, Fisheries Closure, NRDA
- Oiled Wildlife Care Network
- MANY agency partners
