

## **Beaver Restoration Informational Meeting Instructions**

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) invites the public to attend its Beaver Restoration Informational Meeting. The meeting will provide a broad overview of CDFW's Beaver Restoration Program, including its purpose, objectives, tasks, and timelines. Additionally, the meeting will address the implementation of pilot and future beaver translocation projects, development of a beaver co-existence toolkit, and policy updates. The meeting will conclude with a public question and answer session. Future public workshops will be scheduled to discuss human-beaver coexistence strategies and the process for developing and requesting beaver translocation projects.

This meeting marks the first in a series of informational meetings and workshops intended to inform tribes, stakeholders, and the public about CDFW's beaver management efforts and activities.
