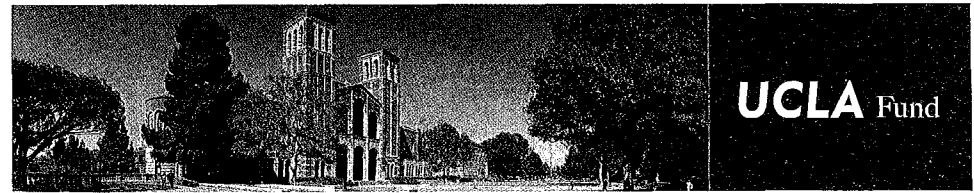

**Response 1**

The Corps and CDFG appreciate your opinion regarding protection of the Santa Clara River and the impacts of the proposed Project, and it will be included as part of the record and made available to decision makers prior to a final decision on the proposed Project. Because the comment does not address the content of the Draft EIS/EIR, no additional response is provided.

**Response 2**

The comment expresses commentor's opinion that river permits in the City of Santa Clarita have been ineffective in protecting endangered species in the area. The comment will be included as part of the record and made available to decision makers prior to a final decision on the proposed Project. Please see **Topical Response 3: Natural River Management Plan Projects and Mitigation**, for responsive information to the topic of upstream river permits in the City of Santa Clarita. Because the comment does not address the content of the Draft EIS/EIR, no additional response is provided.

**Response 3**

The comment addresses general concerns related to species found on the Project site. Potential impacts to animals and plants received extensive analysis in the Draft EIS/EIR, including **Section 4.5, Biological Resources**. Mitigation measures were designed, wherever feasible, to avoid or minimize impacts to wildlife. In addition, for further responsive information, please see revised **Section 4.5** of the Final EIS/EIR. The comment will be included as part of the record and made available to the decision makers prior to a final decision on the proposed Project.
