Response 1

The comment requests that: (i) the public review and comment period be extended, and (ii) special attention be paid to wildlife corridors in the environmental analysis. In response to this and other requests, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) and California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG) extended the comment period for the Draft EIS/EIR. Please refer to **Topical Response 1: EIS/EIR Public Review Opportunities**, for additional responsive information. As to the concerns expressed about wildlife corridors and potential wildlife safety issues, the Draft EIS/EIR contains an extensive evaluation of wildlife corridors in **Subsection 4.5.5.2.4**, Impacts to Wildlife Movement and Habitat Connectivity (pages 4.5-561 through 4.5-596), which addresses potential impacts to wildlife habitat linkages, corridors and crossings. In addition, please refer to **Topical Response 12: Wildlife Habitat Connectivity, Corridors, and Crossings**, and revised **Section 4.5** of the Final EIS/EIR. The comment will be included as part of the record and made available to the decision makers prior to a final decision on the proposed Project.
