ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

*YOU MUST SIGN ALL WAIVERS BEFORE YOU ARE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE!

**PLEASE PRINT OUT ENOUGH NECESSARY WAIVERS FOR YOUR GROUP.

Nonlead ammunition is required when taking any wildlifewith a firearm anywhere in California. Please plan accordingly.

All hunters must have a current California Hunting License and Upland Game Bird Stamp. <u>Hunters possessing a junior hunting license do not need an upland game bird</u> <u>stamp. Junior hunters must be accompanied by a non-shooting adult 18 years of age or</u> <u>older.</u>

All shooters and non-shooters MUST wear shooting safety glasses with an ANSI rating of Z87.1 or above while in the hunting field. Glasses will be available for loan. A blaze orange hunting vest or similar safety apparel is required for all person's in the field. If the hunter does not bring one, an orange vest will be provided.

Please come prepared and wear appropriate gear for the hunt. We strongly recommend you bring water, a hat, thick jeans to ward off the vegetation, sturdy shoes/boots, sweater/jacket, mosquito repellant and a cooler with ice for your birds.

For safety, Junior hunters must have a properly fitted shotgun. Please note if you are not prepared for the hunt or your gear is deemed unsafe you may be asked to withdraw from the hunt. Junior hunters may have **only TWO shot shells** in the magazine or chamber while hunting.

HUNTING DOGS

You may bring your own hunting dog, but you are required to obey hunter etiquette and maintain control of your dog at all times in the field. Be sure to have enough water for your dog. If your dog does not remain in your control, you will be asked to leave your dog in your vehicle. This is not a training opportunity for dogs.

The Upland Game Bird Special Hunt Program is pleased to offer you this opportunity. There is no fee for this hunt; it is sponsored by California Department of Fish and Wildlife/Upland Game Bird "Special Hunt" Program. Practice good sportsmanship, enjoy your hunt and most of all, be a safe hunter.

The Ten Commandments of Firearms Safety:

- 1. Watch that muzzle! Keep it pointed in a safe direction at all times.
 - 2. Treat every firearm with the respect due a loaded gun.
- 3. Be sure of your target and what is in front of it and beyond it.
- 4. Keep your finger outside the trigger guard until ready to shoot .
 - 5. Check your barrel and ammunition.
 - 6. Unload firearms when not in use.
 - 7. Point your firearm only at something you intend to shoot.
 - 8. Don't run, jump, or climb with a loaded firearm.
 - 9. Store firearms and ammunition separately and safely.
- 10. Don't drink alcohol, use drugs or take medications that might impair your abilities and good judgment before or while handling firearms or archery equipment.

Waiver And Release Of Claims: I hereby expressly waive any right that I might have to sue the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers for any physical or emotional injuries, illnesses, death or other damages that I might suffer as a result of participating in hunting activities on State property._____.

Waiver And Release Of Claims Based On Negligence: In addition to the inherent dangers involved in hunting on State property described above, I further acknowledge that serious injuries or death may be caused by the negligent acts of State employees, its agents, volunteers or other persons which increase the risk of injury beyond those normally anticipated while hunting. I hereby expressly agree to assume the risk that I may be seriously injured or killed through the negligent acts of others. I agree to waive any right I may have to sue the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers for injuries or death that I may suffer arising out of participating in hunting or related activities including physical or emotional injuries, illnesses or death caused by the negligent acts of the State, its agents, employees, volunteers or other persons.

Waiver of Minor's Potential Claims and Release of Liability

I hereby expressly agree that the Child assumes the risk that the Child may be seriously injured or killed through the negligent acts of others. I agree to waive any right the Child may have to sue the State, its agents, employees and/or volunteers for injuries or death that the Child may suffer arising out of participating in hunting or related activities including physical or emotional injuries, illnesses or death caused by the negligent acts of the State, its agents, employees, volunteers or other persons.
