Cosco Busan Trustee Council Resolution Regarding Disbursement of Funds for Restoration Projects for Fiscal Year 2013-14

- 1. The State of California, acting through the Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) and the California State Lands Commission (CSLC); the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA); and the Department of the Interior (DOI), acting through the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and the National Park Service (NPS), are the trustees responsible for restoring those natural resources injured by the discharge of oil from the *M/V Cosco Busan* on November 7, 2007.
- 2. Sums recovered in the civil action United States v. *M/V Cosco Busan* et al., and related actions, are being held in the DOI Natural Resource Damage Assessment and Restoration Fund (NRDAR Fund) and the San Francisco Bay Shoreline Parks and Recreational Use account established by the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF Rec Account).
- **3.** The Trustees have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) among themselves for the purpose of coordinating their trust responsibilities.
- **4.** The MOU specifies several procedural prerequisites to the implementation of projects selected in the Restoration Plan. Among other things, a selected project may not proceed unless a lead Trustee has been designated for that project and the Trustee Council has given its written authorization to commence the project.
- 3. The MOU further requires the Trustee Council to memorialize all expenditures of funds from the above-referenced accounts in a Trustee Council Resolution signed by the participating voting members. The settlement funds may only be used for the design, implementation, permitting (as necessary), monitoring and oversight of restoration projects and for the costs of complying with the requirements of law to conduct a restoration planning and implementation process. The use of such funds must be documented and an accounting provided to the Cosco Busan Trustee Council.
- **4.** The Trustee Council hereby authorizes the disbursement as described below:
 - \$39,037 from the NRDAR Fund to USGS for the implementation of the Marbled Murrelet Restoration Project ("Non-Breeding Seasonal Dispersal by Steller's Jays").
- 5 The Trustee Council hereby authorizes the following re-allocation of funds (already disbursed) as described below:
 - \$40,693 of funds previously dispersed to NOAA is to be reallocated to phase 2 (step 2) of the "Assessment of Genetic Spatial Structure of *Fucus* spp. for Potential Donor and Recipient Locations in San Francisco Bay for the Cosco Busan Rockweed Restoration Project." No distribution from the NRDAR Fund is required, as NOAA still has unused funds that were previously allocated to oyster restoration. The amount of \$40,693 will be
