Proposed Regulatory Language

Section 28.15, Title 14 CCR, is amended to read:

OPTION 1: Change bag limit in northern California only (consistent with emergency regulation)

§28.15. Halibut, California Halibut.

- (a) The following restrictions apply to the recreational taking of California halibut:
 - (1) Daily Bag and Possession Limit:
 - (A) Five in In waters south of a line extending due west magnetic from Point Sur, Monterey County,: Five
 - (B) and three in In waters north of a line extending due west magnetic from Point Sur, Monterey County-: Two
- (b) (2) Minimum size: Twenty-two inches total length.

OPTION 2: Change the bag limit in northern California and in southern California

§28.15. Halibut, California Halibut.

- (a) The following restrictions apply to the recreational taking of California halibut:
 - (1) Daily Bag and Possession Limit: <u>Two.</u> Five in waters south of a line extending due west magnetic from Point Sur, Monterey County, and two in waters north of a line extending due west magnetic from Point Sur, Monterey County.
- (b) (2) Minimum size: Twenty-two inches total length.
