

California Fish and Game Commission February 14, 2024 Field Trip Details

Who: Commissioners, staff, California Department of Fish and Wildlife staff, and members of the public

What: Field trip to learn more about archery and bowhunting, and to engage in archery shooting

When: Wednesday, January 14, 2024, approximately 3:15 p.m. to 5:15 p.m.

Where: 3680 Industrial Boulevard, Suite 300, West Sacramento, CA 95691 (back side of the building, on the dock side)

The Commission invites members of the public to join commissioners, staff, and California Department of Fish and Wildlife staff for a field trip Wednesday afternoon. Members of the public must provide their own transportation.

This field trip takes place inside a warehouse with a large door open to the outdoors. Rain is expected, so please bring appropriate clothing for the conditions.

Meeting Location

Meet at the California Department of Fish and Wildlife warehouse at 3680 Industrial Boulevard, Suite 300 in West Sacramento. Meet at the loading dock; presentations and demonstrations will be held inside the warehouse.

Field Trip Overview

Explore archery and bowhunting with education staff from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, California Bowmen Hunters/State Archery Association, and Gaines and Associates!

Topics to be covered during this field trip include a general overview of archery and the art of archery hunting, types of archery equipment, archery safety, expanding archery hunting opportunities, bow hunting classes offered by the department's Hunter Education Program, archery education programs in schools, and use of "archery only" tags for big game hunting in areas where high human-wildlife conflicts exist. Various styles of bows used to hunt these days will be demonstrated and educators available to answer questions.

Participants will have an opportunity to try out — or test — their archery skills. Whether you are a seasoned archer, beginner, or just starting to gain interest in archery and bow hunting, this is a great opportunity to further your knowledge to hone your skills. All equipment will be provided and personal archery gear will not be allowed.

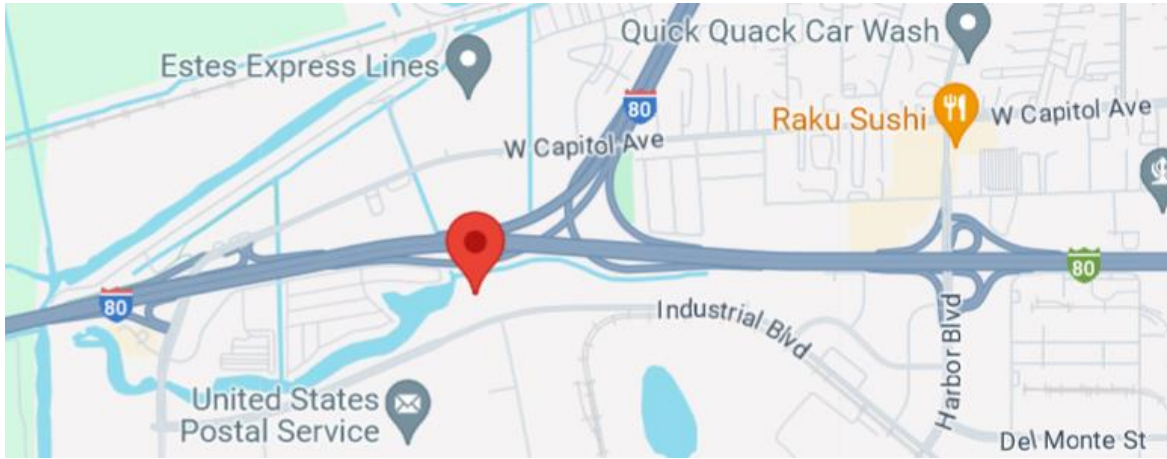
