

California Natural Resources Agency Building – Area Guide

The CNRA building is located at [715 P Street](#) in downtown Sacramento.

Parking and transportation

- Parking in the area is somewhat limited, so we recommend carpooling or using alternative transportation, if possible.
 - o For **state employees**, the Department of General Services (DGS) offers discounted, daily parking at two parking facilities in downtown Sacramento. The \$8 daily rate (cash only) is available on a first-come, first-served basis. A state employee ID badge is required at the time of payment and there are no in/out privileges. For the general public, parking is \$20/day.

- o There is a private parking lot on 8th street between T and R which is \$6/day
- o Street parking is generally time-limited, but if you plan to use street parking, the [ParkMobile app](#) makes life easier.
- o The closest City of Sacramento parking garage is the Capitol Garage at 1125 10th street, \$10/day. Daily parking at most of the city of Sacramento's garages can be reserved and pre-paid online [on their ParkWhiz website](#).
- o You can use the [interactive map on the city of Sacramento's website](#) to find parking.
- Alternative transportation
 - o Bike racks are available in front of the building (bring a lock), but please note that there are no bike lanes on the streets immediately surrounding the building.
 - o The 8th and O light rail station is only one block away. You can [plan your trip on the Sacramento Regional Transport Trip Planner](#).
 - o The [Sacramento Amtrack station](#) is approximately one mile away. Enjoy the 20-minute walk or grab a [Lime scooter](#).

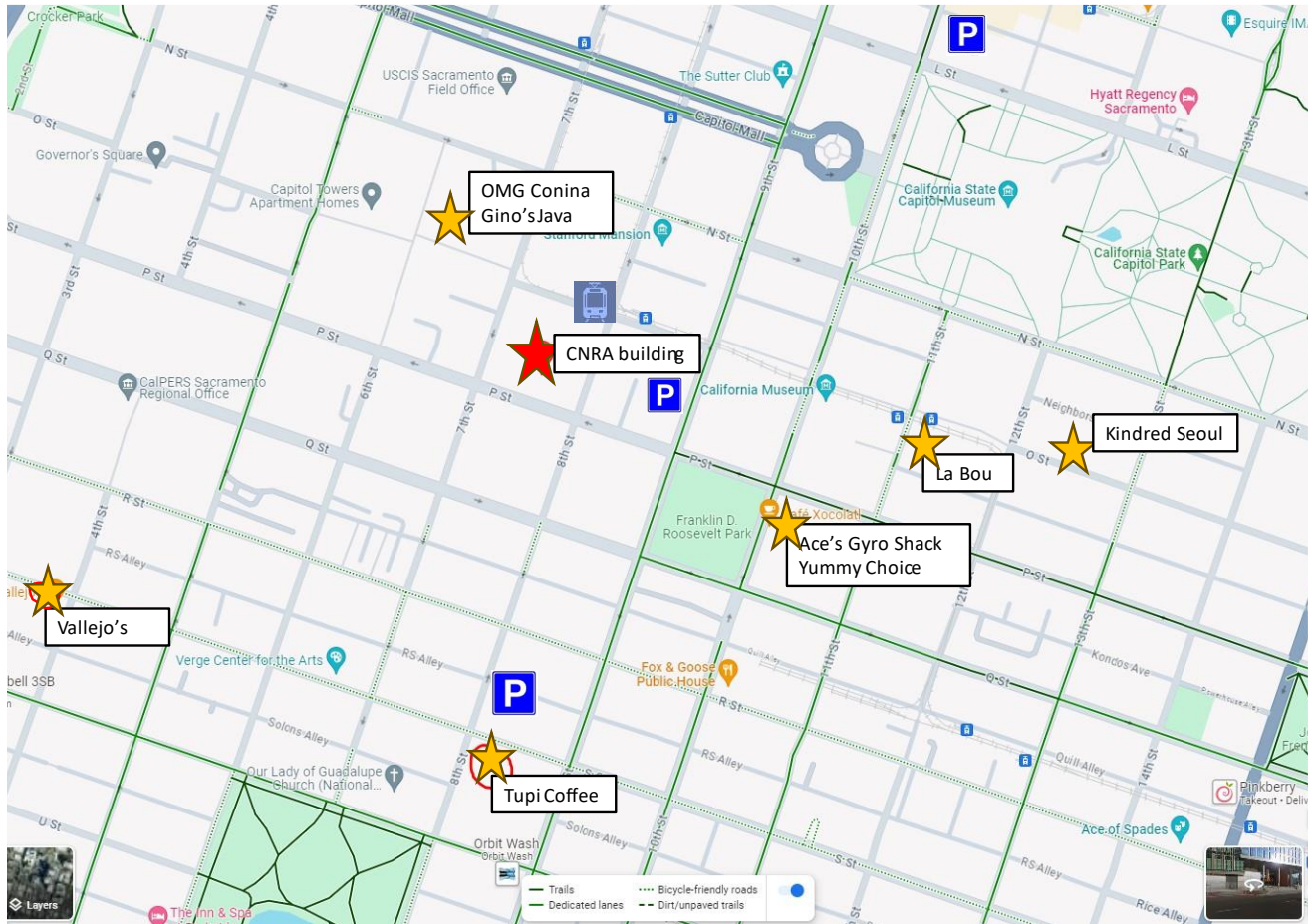


Figure 1 Local Eateries near the CNRA Building
