General Area: Eastern Siskiyou County, private timberland, Whaleback pack area

General situation and animal information: On the morning of September 20 there was a cluster of locations from OR85's satellite collar indicating that there may be a carcass at that location. The producers investigated the area and found a 1400 lb. cow. Another cow was found a half mile away, that had died while calving. Both were investigated by Siskiyou County personnel that day.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The 1400 lb. cow had external bite marks with associated subcutaneous and musculature hemorrhage of the size and location indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Wolf tracks were present in the area.

Summary: Evidence indicated that the 1st cow was killed by wolves. There was no evidence that the second cow that died while calving was killed by wolves.
