General Area: Eastern Siskiyou County, private property, Whaleback pack area

General situation and animal information: The carcass of a young cow who had been in labor was discovered the morning of November 18 and investigated by Siskiyou County personnel the same day. A partial carcass of the calf was found in the area. During the investigation a live cow behaviorally gave indication that she was distraught and missing a calf. The behavior of the cow led investigators to a second calf carcass.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The carcass of the cow and both calves had external bite marks with associated subcutaneous and musculature hemorrhage of the size and location indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Wolf tracks were present in the area and OR85's satellite collar data showed presence at the site that morning.

Summary: Evidence indicated that the cow and both calves were killed by wolves.
