**Cause of Death:**

- Confirmed Wolf – 1 dead lamb, 3 injured lambs
- Probable Wolf
- Possible Wolf
- Non-Wolf Depredation
- Non-Depredation
- Unknown

**General Area:** Eastern Plumas County, private property, Beyem Seyo pack area.

**General situation and animal information:** One dead and three injured lambs were discovered on the morning of January 2. USDA Wildlife Services investigated the next day.

**Physical evidence of wolf predation:** The carcass had external bite marks with associated subcutaneous and muscle hemorrhage. The injured animals had injuries consistent with a wolf attack.

**Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury:** LAS23F's satellite collar was detected at the location the evening before the discovery.

**Summary:** Evidence indicated that one lamb was killed, and three lambs were injured by wolves.
