General Area: Western Lassen County, private property, Harvey pack area.

General situation and animal information: A calf carcass was found on January 20. Wildlife Services was able to investigate the carcass on January 22.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of teeth marks with associated hemorrhage were indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: WHA05F's satellite collar was located near the carcass in the early morning hours of January 20.

Summary: All evidence indicated that the calf was killed by wolves.
