TO ALL INTERESTED AND AFFECTED PARTIES:

This is to provide you with a continuation notice concerning the proposed regulations for mammal hunting (Bighorn Sheep, Pronghorn, Elk Hunting, Co-op Hunting Regulations, and Preference Points), published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on February 2, 2024, Notice No. Z2024-0123-07, and scheduled for adoption by the California Fish and Game Commission (Commission) on April 18, 2024.

This notice provides notice of revisions to the proposed regulatory language in sections 363 and 555.1, Title 14, California Code of Regulations (CCR). No revisions are being made to sections 362, 364, 364.1, 554, 555, or 708.14, Title 14, CCR.

Because these regulations are different from, yet sufficiently related to, the originally proposed regulations, the Administrative Procedure Act requires that we make these changes available to you for a written comment period. The proposed changes to the regulations are clearly indicated on the attached revised proposed regulatory text as follows: additions of newly proposed text are shown in <u>double underline</u>; originally proposed text that is now proposed for deletion is shown in <u>single underline double strikeout</u>; originally proposed text not affected by the changes described in this notice is indicated in <u>single underline</u>.

Please refer to the attached description of the specific edits to the regulatory text.
