NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO PROPOSED REGULATIONS.

Pursuant to the requirements of California Government Code Section 11346.8, subdivision (c), and Section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR), the California Fish and Game Commission (Commission) is providing you with a notice of sufficiently related changes to the proposed regulations concerning Special Hunts Permit Issuance and Drawings in ALDS, published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on June 2, 2023, Notice Number Z2023-0519-05, and adopted by the Commission on August 22, 2023.

This 15-day notice provides notice of revisions to the proposed regulatory language in Section 715, Title 14, California Code of Regulations (CCR). No revisions are being made to the proposed regulatory language in Section 702, Title 14, CCR.

Revisions to subsection 715(a) are proposed to describe special hunts more clearly, identify additional hunt specific criteria that the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) will use to establish the parameters of each hunt, add definitions for non-hunter, hunting group and hunting party, revise the definition of new hunter, and add information on when and how special hunt opportunities will be announced. Edits to correct punctuation and add clarity and specificity are also proposed.

Revisions to subsection 715(b)(1) are proposed to abbreviate "Automated License Data System" as "ALDS." No additional revisions to the originally proposed language in subsection 715(b) are proposed.

Revisions to subsections 715(c), (d), and (e) are proposed to provide a description for each permit issuance method to describe the hunt conditions that would favor the Department's selection of that permit issuance method. The procedures for each method are proposed to be updated for clarity, consistency and specificity.

Revisions to subsection 715(f) are proposed to specify how successful applicants will be notified and how to access drawing results electronically through the Department's Online License Sales and Services website.

Because the revised regulations are different from, yet sufficiently related to, the originally proposed regulations, the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires that we make these changes available to you for a 15-day written comment period.

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The proposed changes are clearly indicated on the attached revised proposed regulatory language as follows: Language originally proposed to be added is shown in <u>underline</u>. Language originally proposed to be deleted is shown in strikeout. Language originally proposed to be removed is shown in <u>underline/double strikeout</u>. Language newly proposed to be added is shown in <u>double-underline</u>.

Pursuant to APA requirements, we are providing you with the full text of all sections of the originally proposed regulatory language; however, there are no revisions to the originally proposed regulatory language in Section 702, Title 14, CCR.
