Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Beyom Seyo breeding female (LAS23F) satellite collar locations were in the vicinity on June 2 and wolf tracks were present at the scene.

Summary: Evidence indicated the calf was killed by wolves.
