The Proposed Project consists of removing and replacing the existing Kern River Hatchery siphon and pipeline, operated by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), which is failing and not able to supply water necessary for hatchery operations. The project includes demolition of the existing aboveground siphon pipeline (0.5 mile) and inlet/outlet areas, the construction of a new underground siphon pipeline and inlet/outlet in the same general alignment and locations, and the replacement of an existing open ditch with a buried pipeline connecting the outlet structure to the hatchery.
