

Booking Guided Tours at Nimbus Hatchery

Calendar Reservation System Tutorial

Ready to book a guided tour at the Nimbus Fish Hatchery? Please ensure your group meets the following criteria before continuing:

- ✓ TK-12 schools or community groups, such as scout groups, senior care centers, professional and non-profit organizations, etc.
- ✓ Groups must have a minimum of 15 participants and must not exceed 35 participants.
 - ★ Larger groups must book more than one tour slot and split the group accordingly.

Smaller groups or individuals can join our free public tours offered on a regular basis. Check our [Facebook page](#) for more information regarding these tours.

Step 1

Go to the Tour Dates Calendar and find the date you would like to book a tour for. Please confirm your preferred day has 'seats' (tour slots) remaining, and you have selected your preferred time as each day has two tour time slots (morning vs. afternoon tour).

About the Event

Join one of our naturalists for a free, guided tour at the Nimbus Fish Hatchery to learn more about salmon, steelhead, and the amazing American River! We will explore the Nimbus Visitor Center, the American River Discovery Trail, and the hatchery raceways. During the tour, we will cover the life cycle and biology of steelhead trout, their habitat needs, and human impact on riparian ecosystems. Tours are typically 90 minutes long and must have between 15-35 participants, though larger groups can reserve separate tours.

March through October is non-peak season and our fish ladder is closed during this time. During shoulder season months (i.e. March or October), you can expect to see adult fish in the American River adjacent to the fish hatchery. While this is a slower time at the hatchery, juvenile fish can still be observed in our raceways (concrete holding ponds) and fish food is offered to tour groups.



Troubleshooting Tips

Updating or Cancelling Your Tour

- Look for the 'Update registration' or 'Cancel registration' buttons located in the top right corner of the registration page. Provide the email address used during registration, and we'll send you a confirmation via email. Click on the link in the email to view the event details page. Scroll to the bottom to view your cancellation options.



Adding Additional Registrations

- During registration, you have the option to add another person to your booking. This is great option if you would like to book multiple classrooms for the same date and time. However, you may only add additional registrations if there is more than one remaining seat (tour slot) available.

Getting on the Wait List

- When the last tour slot has been booked, the wait list automatically becomes active. Invitation emails are automatically sent to individuals on the wait list, as seats become available, in the order they signed up. Each invitation is valid only for one registration for this event.

Certain Dates Not Listed

- If there are certain dates not listed as an option when booking a tour, it may be due to a holiday, staff training, or Visitor Center maintenance.
