- USFWS listed the San Francisco Bay-Delta distinct population segment (DPS) of <u>longfin</u> <u>smelt as endangered</u> under the Endangered Species Act. The final rule will be published in the Federal Register and can be <u>viewed online on the regulations.gov</u> website under the Docket No. FWS–R8–ES–2022–0082. This rule will go in effect on August 29, 2024.
- USBR released the public draft EIS for the Long-Term Operation of the CVP and SWP. The public review and comment period runs from July 26 – September 9, 2024. Visit the project website for the materials to review.
- On July 31, 2024, the California Department of Water Resources released the <u>final 2023</u> <u>State Water Project Delivery Capability Report</u> (<u>media release</u>).
