SUBJECT: Request to Publish Notice of Proposed Action for Rulemaking to Amend Section 650, Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Scientific Collection Permits.

Dear Kenneth Pogue:

The purpose of this proposed regulatory change is to provide applicants for Scientific Collecting Permits (SCP) an up-to-date list of at-risk terrestrial invertebrates in California. The Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has determined that scientific, education, and propagation-related take of these at-risk animals should be regulated through the SCP process. Currently these invertebrates are listed on the *California Terrestrial and Vernal Pool Invertebrates of Conservation Priority List (TVPICP List)*. This regulation change updates the TVPICP List, incorporated by reference in Section 650, dated January 2, 2024, based on the same criteria used to create the original list. The Department would like to have this rule effective the first of January 2025. To this end, enclosed for review and approval by the Office of Administrative Law is the initial rulemaking package for the Department's proposed regulation.

The Department requests that the Office of Administrative Law publish notice of this rulemaking in the August 16, 2024, issue of the California Regulatory Notice Register. Attached are the STD Form 400, Notice of Proposed Action, proposed regulatory text, Initial Statement of Reasons, *TVPICP List*, and the STD Form 399 with Addendum.
