**SUBJECT: OSRO RATING LETTER**

This letter is in response to your OSRO application received on June 14, 2007. Pursuant to Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 819, MSRC is rated to deploy the amounts and capacities of equipment in the time frames indicated on the enclosed OSRO Rating Response Matrix. Unless this rating is modified, suspended, or revoked, this rating letter shall remain valid until August 24, 2010 (14, CCR 819.06).

OSRO Ratings are based on the application, verification of actual services provided, equipment and resources available, and established subcontracts and agreements. You are required to notify the Administrator of any significant reductions in equipment or personnel levels in advance, if planned, or within 24 hours of becoming aware of such changes. When new regulatory changes, that affect your response capability, become effective during your rating period, you will be required to update your OSRO application and notify the Administrator (14, CCR 819.04(d)(3)). As a Rated OSRO, MSRC will remain subject to announced and unannounced drills and inspections throughout the term of its rating.
