ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLIANCE ACTIONS AND HEARING PROCEDURES ARTICLE 1. ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLIANCE ACTIONS AND CIVIL PENALTIES

§ 873.5. Administrative Compliance Actions: Government Code Section 8670.67.

(a) The Administrator may issue a Complaint and assess a civil penalty upon any person who intentionally or negligently:

(1) <u>F</u>fails to follow the <u>effective applicable contingency</u> plan (as that term is defined in Title 14, California Code of Regulations Section 815.05), or the direction or orders of the Administrator, or the United States Coast Guard (USCG), or the United States <u>Environmental Protection Agency</u> in connection with an oil spill, except as provided in Government Code <u>s</u>Section 8670.27.

(2) <u>F</u>fails to notify the <u>USCG</u><u>United States Coast Guard</u> that a vessel (as defined in Government Code <u>s</u><u>S</u>ection 8670.20(a)) is disabled within one hour of a disability if, while disabled, the vessel causes a discharge of oil into marine waters or inland waters.

(3) <u>D</u>discharges or spills oil into, or which enters marine waters or inland waters unless the discharge is authorized by the United States, the <u>a federal</u>, <u>S</u>state, or other<u>local</u> agency with appropriate jurisdiction.

(4) <u>F</u>fails to immediately begin cleanup, abatement, or removal of spilled oil in the manner prescribed by <u>Government Code</u> <u>s</u>Section 8670.25-of the Government Code.

(5) <u>F</u>fails to comply with the provisions of <u>c</u>Chapter 7.4 of the Government Code (commencing with <u>s</u>Section 8670.1) or dDivision 7.8 of the Public Resources Code (commencing with <u>s</u>Section 8750) and any regulations, permits or orders issued or promulgated pursuant to those sections.
