General situation and animal information: A dead yearling bull was found in the afternoon of October 6 and was investigated by CDFW staff on the morning of October 7.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The location of bite marks with associated premortem hemorrhage were indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Wolf tracks were observed around the carcass.

Summary: Evidence indicated the yearling was killed by a wolf.
