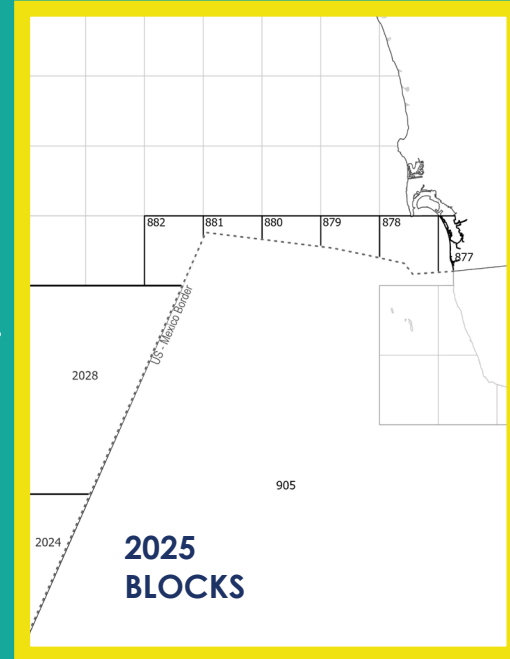
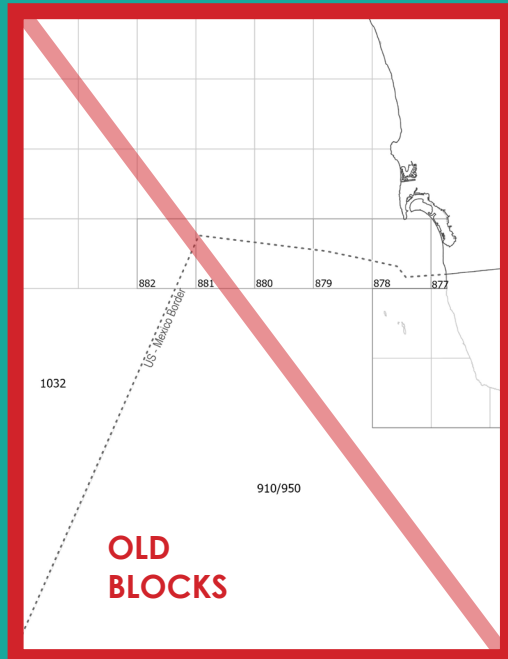
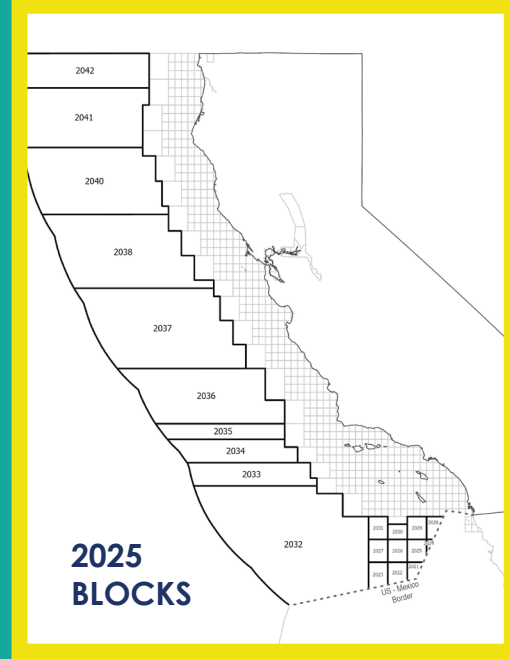


NEW Commercial Fishing Block Charts

starting January 1, 2025

- Effective January 1, 2025, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) requires the use of a revised California Fisheries Chart, also known as Fishing Block Chart, when reporting fishing activity on CDFW required forms (14CCR §190), including fish tickets and logbooks.
- This change is needed to correct for:
 - Blocks that overlap with other blocks of a different scale
 - Blocks with poor alignment with the U.S./Mexico border
