Summary of Previous/Future Actions (N/A)

Background

The next Commission meeting is scheduled for February 12-13, 2025 in Sacramento, with phone and webinar options for members of the public to participate remotely. Potential agenda items for this meeting are provided in Exhibit 1 for consideration and potential Commission approval. No unusual logistics are expected.

Currently, Commission and committee meetings are scheduled for the Sacramento area through June 2025. Due to ongoing travel restrictions and anticipated budget constraints through at least the end of the current fiscal year, staff believes it is prudent for Commission and committee meetings to be held in Sacramento for the remainder of the 2025 calendar year.

Staff received a commissioner request to change the dates of the June 18-19, 2025 Commission meeting, so as not to conflict with Juneteenth (June 19).

- Moving the meeting to June 17-18 overlaps completely with a Pacific Fishery Management Council (PFMC) meeting, which would be challenging for Department Marine Region colleagues.
- Moving the meeting to the following week, June 25-26, would require moving the July Marine Resources Committee meeting forward a week and the August Commission meeting forward a week, in order to keep four weeks between meetings.
- Moving the meeting to a week earlier on Tuesday and Wednesday, June 10-11, as well as swapping marine and wildlife days, avoids overlapping with the PFMC meeting and provides a day of travel for Department Marine Region staff participating in the PFMC meeting.

Note that for two-day Commission meetings in 2025, wildlife and inland fisheries items will be heard on the first day, and marine items will be heard on the second day (except potentially in June, depending on whether and when the June Commission meeting is moved.
