General situation and animal information: Two yearling steers were found dead on October 28 and were investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of bite marks associated with hemorrhage on both carcasses were indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: WHA05F satellite collar was located in the area of the carcasses the previous night. Wolf tracks and scat were also present at the scene.

Summary: Evidence indicated that both steers were killed by wolves.
