General situation and animal information: A dead calf was found in the afternoon of November 1 and was investigated the same day by CDFW staff.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The location of bite marks with associated subcutaneous hemorrhage were indicative of a wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Wolf tracks were observed around the carcass and Yowlumni GPS collar data (YOW01F, YOW03F, and YOW06M)indicated wolf presence in the location that the calf was found.

Summary: Evidence indicated that the calf was killed by wolves.
