

**LIVESTOCK LOSS DETERMINATION**

**General Area:** Central Tulare County, Tule River Tribe Reservation, Yowlumni pack area

**General situation and animal information:** A dead calf was found in the afternoon of November 1 and was investigated the same day by CDFW staff.

**Physical evidence of wolf predation:** The location of bite marks with associated subcutaneous hemorrhage were indicative of a wolf attack.

**Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury:** Wolf tracks were observed around the carcass and Yowlumni GPS collar data (YOW01F, YOW03F, and YOW06M) indicated wolf presence in the location that the calf was found.

**Summary:** Evidence indicated that the calf was killed by wolves.
