Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of bite marks and associated hemorrhage were indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: DNA from LAS32F and a previously unknown male wolf was collected from the carcass, as well as wolf tracks and scat.

Summary: Evidence indicated the heifer was killed by wolves.
