

LIVESTOCK LOSS DETERMINATION

General Area: Western Lassen County, private property, Harvey pack area

General situation and animal information: A yearling heifer was found dead on November 16 and was investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of bite marks and associated hemorrhage were indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: WHA05F satellite collar locations were in the vicinity of the carcass the night before, as well as wolf tracks and scat.

Summary: Evidence indicated the heifer was killed by wolves.
