



Region 1/Region 2 Barrier ID: W003 (Priority Barrier).

Barrier Name: SR-36E Mill Creek to Chester.

Linear Infrastructure: SR-36E.

Geographic Area: Tehama and Plumas County, Mill Creek to Chester.

Length: 34.05 km (21.16 mi).

Target Species: Deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*), Cascades frog (*Rana cascadae*), fisher (*Pekania pennanti*), mesocarnivores.

Connectivity Concerns: The barrier significantly disrupts (>50%) a linkage identified in a species movement study, regional connectivity study, or Conceptual Area Protection Plan, or significantly disrupts connectivity between or within important habitat blocks. It bisects an ungulate migration corridor that has been mapped based on GPS collar data or expert knowledge. Data shows roadkill hotspots, significant or consistent wildlife mortality events, or mortality that could lead to population-level impacts for one or more species.

Remediation Goals: Create new crossing structures.

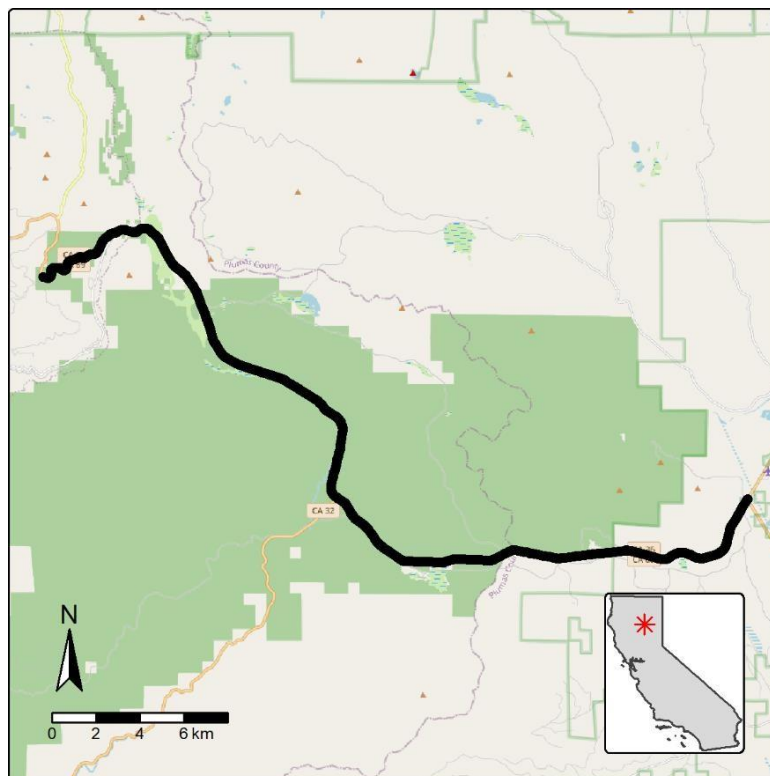


Figure: Barrier W003, on SR-36E, from Mill Creek to Chester.
