Barrier Name: SR-108 Strawberry to US-395.

Linear Infrastructure: SR-108.

Geographic Area: Bumblebee to Sonora Junction.

Length: 75.22 km (46.75 mi).

Target Species: Black bear (*Ursus americanus*), fisher (*Pekania pennanti*), gray wolf (*Canis lupus*), mountain lion (*Puma concolor*), deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*), Sierra Nevada red fox (*Vulpes vulpes necator*), Yosemite toad (*Anaxyrus canorus*).

Connectivity Concerns: SR-108 bisects a known deer seasonal migration route and alpine species populations in the Sierra Nevada Mountains.

Remediation Goals: Expand and enhance existing infrastructure such as culverts and creek bridges, add new under-crossings and wildlife exclusion fencing.
