



Region 4 Barrier ID: W039 (Priority Barrier).

Barrier Name: SR-180 Kings Canyon Foothills.

Linear Infrastructure: SR-180.

Geographic Area: Dunlap to Wilsonia.

Length: 22.22 km (13.81 mi).

Target Species: Badger (*Taxidea taxus*), black bear (*Ursus americanus*), fisher (*Pekania pennanti*), gray wolf (*Canis lupus*), mountain lion (*Puma concolor*), deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*).

Connectivity Concerns: SR-180 bisects a known deer seasonal migration route in the Sierra Nevada Mountains.

Remediation Goals: Expand and enhance existing infrastructure such as culverts and creek bridges, add new under-crossings and wildlife exclusion fencing.
