

Region 1 Barrier ID: W063 (Barrier).

Barrier Name: US-395 South Alturas along Likely Tables.

Linear Infrastructure: US-395.

Geographic Area: Modoc County.

Length: 17.67 km (10.98 mi).

Target Species: Pronghorn (*Antilocapra americana*), deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*), mesocarnivores.

Connectivity Concerns: The barrier significantly disrupts (>50%) a linkage identified in a species movement study, regional connectivity study, or Conceptual Area Protection Plan, or significantly disrupts connectivity between or within important habitat blocks. It bisects an ungulate migration corridor that has been mapped based on GPS collar data or expert knowledge. Some evidence indicates sensitive or high priority species present that may be impacted by the barrier. Expert knowledge or data indicates wildlife mortality of two or more species, but population-level impacts not expected.

Remediation Goals: Fence modification to improve passage/direct animals to potential undercrossing.




Figure: Barrier W063, on US-395 South Alturas along Likely Tables in Modoc County.
