



Region 2 Barrier ID: W094 (Barrier).

Barrier Name: US-50, Aerojet.

Linear Infrastructure: US-50.

Geographic Area: Sacramento County, Nimbus to Prairie City Road and US-50.

Length: 4.81 km (2.99 mi).

Target Species: Deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*), small mammals.

Connectivity Concerns: This stretch of US-50 is adjacent to open space at the Prairie City State Vehicle Recreation Area where wildlife is still present and may attempt to cross the highway for daily or seasonal movements. Resident deer in the Motherlode deer herd are present.

Remediation Goals: Expand and enhance existing infrastructure such as culverts and creek bridges, add new wildlife crossing structures and wildlife exclusion fencing.
