



Region 4 Barrier ID: W099 (Barrier).

Barrier Name: Oakhurst - Wawona.

Linear Infrastructure: SR-41.

Geographic Area: Oakhurst to Wawona.

Length: 27.23 km (16.92 mi).

Target Species: Black bear (*Ursus americanus*), fisher (*Pekania pennanti*), gray wolf (*Canis lupus*), mountain lion (*Puma concolor*), deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*).

Connectivity Concerns: SR-41 bisects a known deer seasonal migration route in the Sierra Nevada Mountains.

Remediation Goals: Expand and enhance existing infrastructure such as culverts and creek bridges, add new under-crossings and wildlife exclusion fencing.
