



Region 4 Barrier ID: W100 (Barrier).

Barrier Name: Groveland - Yosemite.

Linear Infrastructure: SR-120.

Geographic Area: Groveland to Yosemite.

Length: 37.00 km (23.00 mi).

Target Species: Black bear (*Ursus americanus*), fisher (*Pekania pennanti*), gray wolf (*Canis lupus*), mountain lion (*Puma concolor*), deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*).

Connectivity Concerns: SR-120 bisects a known deer seasonal migration route in the Sierra Nevada Mountains.

Remediation Goals: Expand and enhance existing infrastructure such as culverts and creek bridges, add new under-crossings and wildlife exclusion fencing.

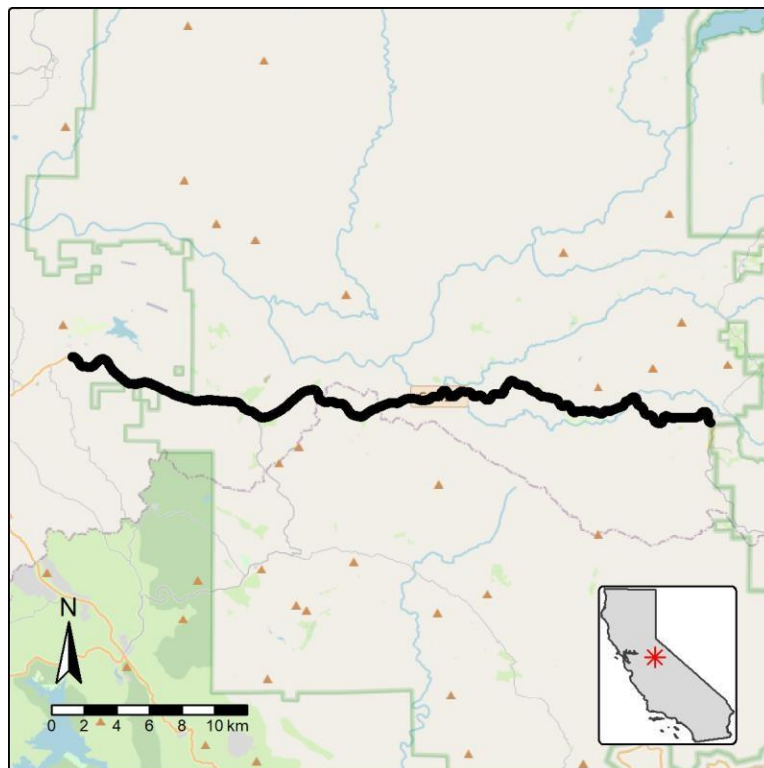


Figure: SR-120 (Buck Meadows) between Groveland and Yosemite is a Region 4 wildlife connectivity barrier.
