



**Region 2 Barrier ID: W181 (Barrier).**

**Barrier Name:** SR-49, Nashville to El Dorado.

**Linear Infrastructure:** SR-49.

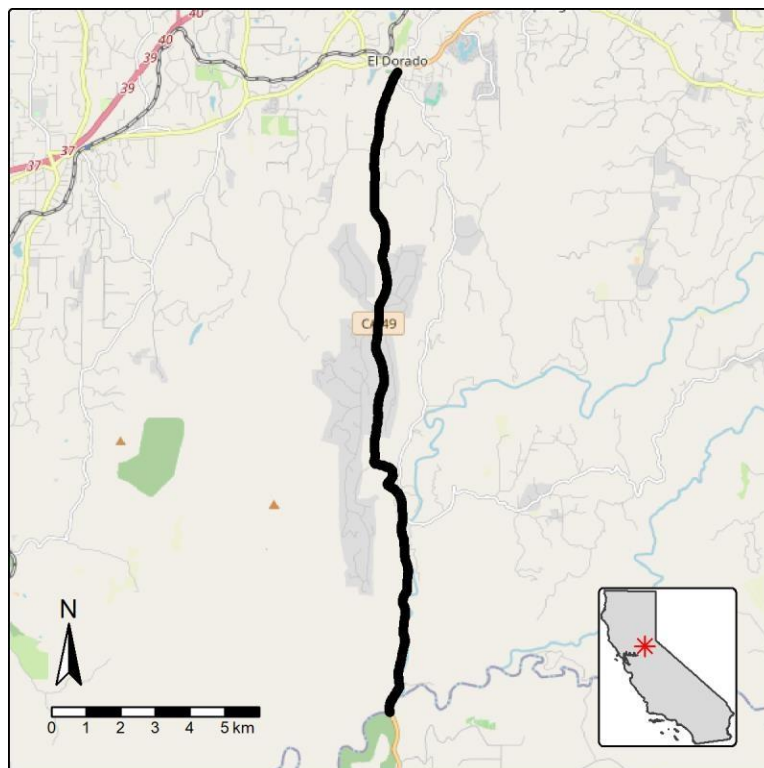
**Geographic Area:** El Dorado County, SR-49 from Enterprise through Nashville to the town of El Dorado.

**Length:** 15.93 km (9.90 mi).

**Target Species:** Deer (*Odocoileus hemionus*), mountain lion (*Puma concolor*), black bear (*Ursus americanus*).

**Connectivity Concerns:** This stretch of SR-49 sees animal vehicle collision as resident wildlife and deer from the Motherlode and Grizzly Flat deer herd make daily or seasonal movements.

**Remediation Goals:** Expand and enhance existing infrastructure such as culverts and creek/river bridges, add new wildlife crossing structures and wildlife exclusion fencing.
