



Region 3 Barrier ID: W202 (Barrier).

Barrier Name: SR-37.

Linear Infrastructure: SR-37.

Geographic Area: Along the Northern San Pablo Bay.

Length: 28.45 km (17.68 mi).

Target Species: Salt-marsh harvest mouse (*Reithrodontomys raviventris*), herpetofauna, small-medium sized mammals, shorebirds and waterfowl.

Connectivity Concerns: This road bisects marshland that is habitat for sensitive species and water birds. Roadkill is high and often occurs in the center median. There is a planned road-widening project.

Remediation Goals: This road could be somewhat safe for small animals to cross during the night, outside of commute hours, if the median barrier is constructed to allow better permeability in the short term. Two habitat projects and bridge improvements are planned. Ultimately, this road is proposed to be an elevated causeway.

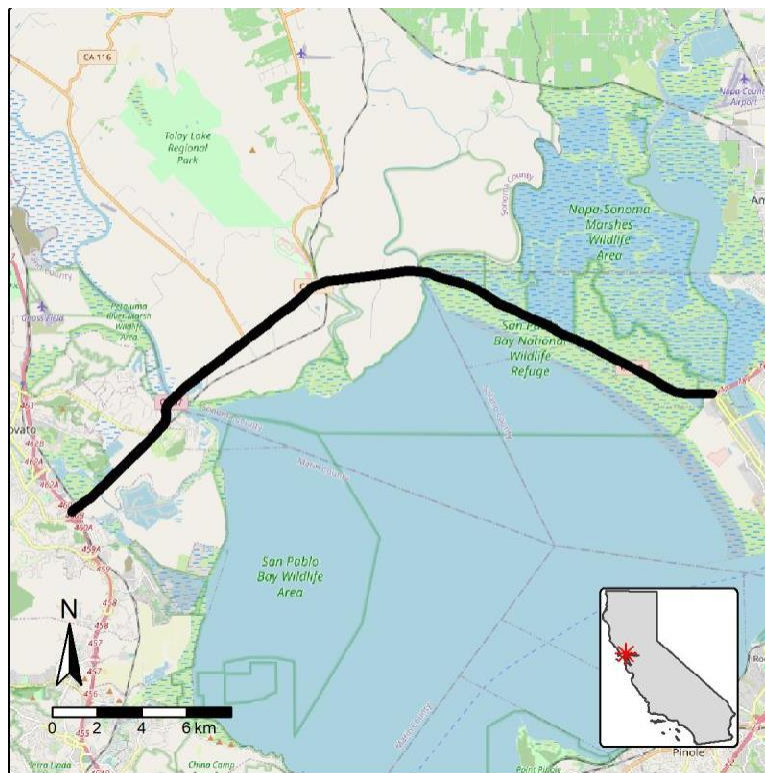


Figure: W202, SR-37 along San Pablo Bay.
