**General situation and animal information**: A dead calf was reported on February 26 and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

**Physical evidence of wolf predation:** The size and location of teeth marks and severity of associated tissue trauma on the calf was indicative of wolf attack.

**Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury**: Wolf tracks were present at the scene.

**Summary**: Evidence indicated the calf was killed by a wolf or wolves. DNA from multiple Whaleback pack yearlings were found on the calf, though the collared wolves in this pack remained in Siskiyou County.
