**General situation and animal information**: A dead calf was reported on 30 March and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

**Physical evidence of wolf predation:** The carcass had been heavily scavenged, with only portions of the hide and a hind leg remaining. No evidence of premortem wounds were found on the remains. No attack or kill scene was found.

**Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury**: Radio collared Harvey pack wolves were in the area around the estimated time of death.

**Summary**: Wolf location data places multiple radio collared wolves in the vicinity of the carcass near the time of death. However, no physical evidence of predation could be found due to the limited amount of remains. This is a possible wolf depredation.
