General situation and animal information: A dead calf was reported on 23 April and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: Premortem bite wounds were found on the hindquarters, back of neck, and groin. The size and location of premortem teeth marks was indicative of a coyote attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: None found.

Summary: Evidence indicated the calf was killed by coyotes.
