**Physical evidence of wolf predation:** Premortem bite wounds were found on the throat. The size and location of premortem teeth marks was indicative of coyote attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: None found.

**Summary**: Evidence indicated the calf was killed by coyotes. Swabs taken of the premortem tooth scrapes and from hair on a nearby fence confirmed coyote DNA.
