**NOTICE OF SECOND 15-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD  
FOR MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS**

June 9, 2025

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Office of Spill Prevention and Response (OSPR) is providing this 15-day notice of modifications made to the Environmental Sensitive Site Protection rulemaking action.

As described in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking and throughout the Initial Statement of Reasons, the intent of this rulemaking action is to repeal the 2013 Shoreline Protection Tables, which includes a Small Harbor Table, and replace it with a new table and regulations at section 828.1 in title 14 of the California Code of Regulations. The Administrative Procedure Act requires that regulations proposed for adoption and/or repeal be illustrated in underline and strikeout, respectively. It has been discovered that the Small Harbor Table was not illustrated properly (in all strikeout), similar to the rest of the Shoreline Protection Table. This additional 15-day comment period merely aims to correct that oversight.

No additional changes are made.
