General Area: Southern Plumas County, private property, Beyem Seyo pack area

General situation and animal information: A dead calf was reported on May 9 and investigated the same day by USDA Wildlife Services.

Physical evidence of wolf predation: The size and location of premortem teeth marks and associated premortem hemorrhaging was indicative of wolf attack.

Evidence of wolf presence near the time of the animal(s) death/injury: Radio collared wolves from the Beyem Seyo pack did not have locations in the area around the estimated time of death, however wolf tracks and signs of an attack were found.

Summary: Evidence indicated the calf was killed by wolves.
